What's Been Going On

This letter has been a long-time coming; it's been quite the summer! On July 13th, my mum was admitted to hospital in a severe state of confu-

sion and was scheduled to remain there for 60 days while the staff assessed her dementia. I was blessed to visit and spend a few days with my parents in early August and had the chance to see Mum in hospital. Unfortunately, it was to be the last time I'd see her. Just a few weeks later, her condition rapidly deteriorated and on September 18th, doctors advised us that she was nearing the end. Lisa, Ethan, and I grabbed the next available flight, but still arrived about 8 hours too late to see Mum. We are still in England as we write this; Mum's funeral is on October 3rd.

We continue in the process of raising additional funding and selling our home in preparation for our move to the UK. We're definitely noticing it's a depressed economy and housing market—we've had just 2 people view our house in 2 months!

If you watch the news, you probably saw the riots erupting in the UK last month. The nation was gripped with fear and Britain's Prime Minister, David Cameron, said that the riots could be blamed on a "slow-motion moral collapse" of the country. This is a society that is in desperate need of hope—a hope they could have through a relationship with Christ.

Please continue to pray for our additional support needs and that we are able to sell our house so we can serve in the UK as soon as possible.

As you are probably aware, FamilyLife is a subsidiary of Campus Crusade for Christ International (CCCI). During our staff conference this year, CCCI announced that the US ministry is changing its name to Cru! More than 20 years ago CCCI's founder, Bill Bright, had already considered changing the name as he had envisioned the ministry would grow way beyond a "campus ministry", but the current name gives that impression.

Steve Sellers, U.S. National Director of Cru, said the problem with the name "Campus Crusade for Christ" is obviously not with "Christ," but with "campus" and "crusade." A substantial amount of Cru's ministry is now directed at people not on a college campus, such as FamilyLife.

As for removing Christ from their name, Cru addressed the question in the following statement: "We were not trying to eliminate the word Christ from our name. We were looking for a name that would most effectively serve our mission and help us take the gospel to the world. Our mission has not changed. Cru enables us to have discussions about Christ with people who might initially be turned off by a more overtly Christian name. We believe that our interaction and our communication with the world will be what ultimately honors and glorifies Christ." Again, Cru has NOT wavered in their commitment to Christ or their willingness to stand for Him! Cru will continue with its emphasis on evangelism, discipleship and Christian outreaches to the world.
