Ethan, his friend Carter (who flew in from the US), and I (Lisa) cycled 250 miles with 23 **other cyclists from London to Paris to raise funds for FamilyLife's** innovative digital resource, Toucan. We set a goal of raising £60,000, and we have around £50,000 as of today!

The experience of cycling this distance with 25 others left me speechless; and at times breathless! By the third day we had all begun to make deep bonds with one another, and it was a good thing too. On our fourth day, we cycled 67+ miles of open French countryside in 101 degrees. We had very little shade and needed to know how to encourage one another.
