Toward the end of November we visited Chris' parents in England; the first time we had been as a family in over 3 years. Chris' parents continue to struggle with various health-related concerns and visiting them was a chance to evaluate their needs and pray about a long-term plan for their care.

As God would have it, our trip coincided with the FamilyLife UK team's annual "Vision and Equipping Day" on December 4th. Since we were relatively close by (in the same country, at least), we took time to visit with the team in Farnham Common, which is just outside of London. We were greatly encouraged to see the passion and work of the team there and to learn how God is ministering to families in the UK, through discipleship, events and "curry nights". (Ask if you're interested!)

Please be in prayer for us as we seek to know God's will regarding a possible move to the UK to work with FamilyLife there. We have a great passion for the work that is being done in Chris' homeland and we would welcome the opportunity to be closer, and thereby more available to Chris' parents.

In Little Rock, Chris continues his work on the eMentoring software by adding new functionality and implementing improvements to accommodate an increase in people seeking mentor relationships. Chris has also been working on a new HR process to improve efficiency in the evaluation and recruitment of new missionary staff for the ministry.

We remain humbled by your ongoing prayer and support. Without you, we would not be able to serve at FamilyLife and see lives changed.
